# The ORNAA Promising Star Award

## Criteria\*

The nominee demonstrates professional attributes that reflect the competencies for Perioperative Registered Nursing Practice at a beginner or intermediate level (defined by ORNAC mod.1 p. 39). For detailed description of these competencies refer to:

**Operating Room Nurses Association of Canada (ORNAC). (2003). *Recommended Standards, Guidelines, and Position Statements for Perioperative Registered Nursing Practice*. Module 1, pp. 38-46. Toronto: Author.**

**NOTE: It is not necessary to provide examples for every possible point.**

The ORNAA Awards Selection Committee will look for **specific examples** of how the nominee:

- /11 a. Practices professionally.
- /23 b. Provides physical patient care while practicing in the circulating nurse role and the scrub nurse role.
- /12 c. Provides supportive care to patients and to health care team members.
- /13 d. Provides a safe environment to patients and health care team members.
- /4 e. Responds to urgent/emergency situations.
- /11 f. Manages resources.

**/74 total possible points**

Nominees are judged using an objective point system. One point will be given for each example submitted that reflects an ORNAC competency. Each category (a-f above) is rated according to the number of practice competencies detailed by ORNAC, 2003, pp. 42-45.

- The nominator must provide clear concrete examples of how the nominee fulfills the above criteria. To aide this process, refer to;

- The award selection will be made by the ORNAA Awards Committee based on the accompanying score sheet.
- Nominations must be received by **October 1<sup>st</sup>**.
