

District Reports

NCORNA - Pamela Rooney

NCORNA has 182 members of which 3 are honorary, with one associate member. We have had meaningful dinner meetings with good attendance, including: A Female Prospective on Cardiovascular Disease - Dr Heather Cox, Obesity, and Sleep Apnea. Most sites are using the new AHA consent, but, most still have problems. Covenant health is developing their own consent, and in the meantime they are still using their own, although many surgeons still have difficulty with switching to Covenant's (still covers blood and body fluids). Grey Nuns has started Cochlear Implants. Hired two new perioperative positions, will finance them through the ORNAC approved perioperative course, and practicum with a year commitment following. Misericordia has had many Mat leaves, but, now that the temporary leaves are ending, they are worried about permanent positions. RAH will be running their own 6 week Perioperative course (not ORNAC approved) which will be followed by a 6 month clinical, expenses paid. In Leduc, there will no longer an assigned call. If a room runs late, will be asked to stay or cases cancelled. We hope everyone has a happy a healthy summer.
